





G - 2 NOTE POWER CHORD




G - 2 NOTE '4TH' POWER CHORD



REGULAR WAY TO PLAY C BFLAT F PROGRESSION




C BFLAT F PROGRESSION UTILISING THE '4TH' VARIATION
